or sequentially striking multiple strings rapidly with multiple fingers to produce a powerful acoustic effect.

Modern composers and performers continue to blend Guzheng with other musical elements, creating new works with contemporary characteristics, such as Guzheng concertos and chamber music pieces, thereby promoting the development and innovation of Guzheng art.

The traditional playing techniques of Guzheng are an essential part of Guzheng art and the key to learning and mastering Guzheng playing. As times change and society develops, Guzheng art continually innovates and evolves in its inheritance, demonstrating vitality and dynamism. In the future, we should continue to strengthen research and practice in Guzheng art, promoting it to shine even more brilliantly in the context of the new era.

The crisp sound of the tubular bells and xylophone, like the bells of the fairy world, outlines a mysterious picture of the heaven for the audience. Music here is not just a background, it is closely integrated with the pictures and plots, and together weaves a story world full of oriental magic. Through these carefully designed musical elements, the film creators successfully deepened the characterization of the characters, enhanced the visual impact of the scenes, and greatly improved the artistic expression of the entire film. Therefore, the clever use of music in the film not only enriches the audience's sensory experience, but also deepens the cultural connotation and emotional resonance of the film, which is an important source of the charm of film art.
